Opened in 1947, this outstanding course is our most established and was planned by renowned designer Perry Maxwell.

Named for 2 Ozarks golfers, the course rises to the standard that its name implies. Springfield pays tribute to Missouri Amateur Winner, Bill Stewart, and his son Payne Stewart, who won on tour 11 times, including 2 U.S. Opens and 1 PGA Championship.

The course is a 6,162 yard per 70, with design that requires accurate iron play and places a premium on good putting-making it a fun yet challenging layout.

You'll find 2 practice greens, a driving range, fully stocked Pro Shop, snack bar. \$41 for cart and Greens Fees, \$18-\$35 for Clubs.

Enjoy an evening of Double-A Baseball with the Springfield Cards, at Hammons Field. The Springfield Cards will be playing a home series against the San Antonio Missions the week of the Annual Reunion and we have planned a group outing for Thursday, August 8<sup>th</sup>. Redbird Roost Tickets include unlimited ballpark style food buffet and Coca Cola products. Pricing includes transportation.

The Johnny Morris Wonders of Wildlife National Museum & Aquarium is a 350,000 square foot immersive journey to thrill and educate people about the wonders of the natural world. Voted the number one Aquarium in the United States by USA Today in 2021, the facility boasts 1.5 million gallons of aquatic displays as well as 35,000 live animals on display.
